The Alberta Capital Region Wastewater Commission (ACRWC or 'The Commission') is a regional services commission providing wastewater transmission and treatment services to over 300,000 people in 13 municipalities surrounding the City of Edmonton. The ACRWC owns and operates over 200 km of wastewater transmission lines, 5 pumping stations, and a modern state of the art wastewater treatment plant.

Our mission is to provide safe, reliable, cost efficient, and environmentally responsible wastewater transmission and treatment service.

There is an exciting opportunity to join our wastewater team, responsible for maintenance of our plant and pumpstation throughout the Capital Region. Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, the Millwright is primarily responsible for:

- Maintaining and troubleshooting rotating or moving equipment
- Maintaining valves and piping systems
- Interpreting drawings and specifications for installation, modification or repair of equipment
- Serving where necessary on the O&M project team
- Maintaining records and documenting equipment condition
- Performing CM or PM on all mechanical equipment as required
- Developing and establishing work standards and procedures

QUALIFICATIONS

- Millwright Journeyman ticket with interprovincial designation. We will also except candidates that are currently working towards their ticket.
- A valid Class 5 driver's license
- Extensive knowledge of wastewater process is an asset.
- Demonstrated ability to build positive, constructive working relationships with a variety of stakeholders.
- Excellent written and oral communications skills are required.
- Knowledge of permitting and work order systems is an asset.

COMPENSATION

We offer a competitive compensation package including a salary range of \$48.10/hour - \$52.02/hour, comprehensive benefits, a defined pension plan, and a compressed work week of 80 hours biweekly. Candidates without a journeyman ticket may be considered at a lower salary range.
