## Instrumentation/Electrician Technician Permanent Full-time

ARROW is looking for a permanent full-time Instrumentation/Electrician Technician (I&E) to join our Operations and Maintenance (O&M) team. Reporting to the Supervisor, I&E, the role is responsible for:

- Maintaining and troubleshooting DCS, PLCs and network communication devices.
- Calibrating analyzers and transmitters
- Maintaining wiring, motors, lighting systems and other electrical equipment.
- Interpreting drawings and specifications for installation, modification, or repair of equipment.
- Serving where necessary on the O&M project team.
- Maintaining records and documenting equipment condition.
- Performing CMs and PMs on all I&E equipment as required.
- Developing and establishing work standards and procedures.
- Previous experience working with PLC's and Delta V control systems would be an asset.

To be a successful candidate, you must have:

- Both Electrician and Instrumentation Journeyperson tickets with interprovincial designation.
- A valid Alberta Class 5 Motor Vehicle Operator's License with 6 or fewer demerits.
- Strong planning and organization skills.
- The ability to manage shifting priorities.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Some experience with Microsoft Office (i.e. Excel, Outlook, Teams, and Word).
- Ability and willingness to perform work in all types of weather during all four seasons.
- Ability to work under minimal supervision, exercise good judgement and take initiative.

This position will appeal to an individual with the right certification and experience who is looking for a stable and predictable work environment. This position is on a 9/80 schedule (80 hours every 2 weeks). The hours of work are every Monday through Thursday, 6:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., with alternating Fridays until 3 p.m. or off as an Earned Day Off (EDO).

The salary range for this position is \$49.35 to \$53.37 per hour. We also provide a comprehensive benefits package, paid time off, and eligibility for the Local Authorities Pension Plan. We are proud of our friendly and safe working environment.
