

PROJECT NOTICE : TRAIN 4 EXPANSION - UPDATE

UPDATED PROJECT TIMELINES

Implementation and start-up of Train 4 successfully took place near mid-February 2026 and is now tied in with the plant's existing wastewater treatment system. This milestone signifies the next step in completing ARROW's largest expansion since the plant's original opening in the 1980s. As a reminder, this expansion now adds a fourth secondary treatment "train" to ARROW's existing three, however, utilizing Membrane Bioreactor Technology for improved water effluent.

Project substantial construction completion and commissioning activities continue to advance towards the start of May 2026. Process-related testing, maintenance, and warranty periods will take effect upon project turnover. Total project completion (including warranty periods) is planned for June 2028.



EXPECTATIONS

Workspace

Construction traffic from PCL Construction (PCL), and PCL's subcontractors after project completion will result in lower worker vehicle volumes in the area. A maintenance and warranty period of two (2) years will be in place where residents and businesses may, from time-to-time, see worker presence to support project deficiencies; however, should not be concerned unless communicated directly from ARROW Utilities.

Any workspace related to TRAIN 4's construction, maintenance and warranty periods will continue to be isolated to ARROW's plant boundaries and should not affect adjacent lands.

As of September 12, 2025, ARROW Utilities acknowledges the recent grand opening of the Edmonton Strathcona County Footbridge (Amisk Wâciw Âsokan or Beaver Hills Bridge) just west of the primary plant entrance, which has already invited an increasing recreational volume of pedestrians and pets to the area.

Trail Access

Strathcona County's regional trail system surrounding ARROW Utilities boundary continues to be open and unaffected by this capital project. As always, please be mindful of routine traffic and maintenance vehicles entering and leaving our plant (please respect the pedestrian stop signs by our main gate).
